

Visit of Lyon : from Fourviere Basilic to the Old City and its « traboules »

Enjoy a guided tour of Lyon's historic locations

The Renaissance district of the old Lyon, listed by Unesco, is a unique area of Gothic and Renaissance architecture. It is the largest area of this kind in France.

The visit will include the Fourviere Basilic, the old Roman theater and the old city St Just streets and traboules. Fourviere Lyon is perhaps the most historic part of the entire city.

After visiting the Basilica, you will go down to the old St Just area, passing by the Theatre Antique de Fourviere. It is another must-see as it is a wonderfully restored theater from the time of Gallo-Roman rule.

The visit will end with a walking through the famous traboules of Lyon. These passageways going from one street to the next via corridors through houses hide superbly renovated architectural treasures.

After the visit, during your free time you will have the possibility to visit the gothic St Jean cathedral, walk along the banks of the Saone river, or going for Shopping around the Place Bellecour, between the Saone and Rhone rivers.
